FAQs for Smart India Hackathon 2019 participants

How do I register for Smart India Hackathon 2019?

***We strongly encourage all participating team members to begin their team registration process by downloading Smart India Hackathon SIH App from Google Play Store.

Please note:

- **1.** Please note that the registration of SIH App and that of the designated website is separate and both have to be completed.
- 2. Registration of teams must be done by a Team Leader only. The registration process is simple. All you need to do is...
 - Visit sih.gov.in
 - · Create a login id for your team
 - · Fill all the required fields
 - Don't forget to click 'Submit'
 - Bingo! You are now ready to submit your application.

How should we form a team?

- All team members should be from same college; no inter-college teams are allowed. However, members from different branches of the same college/ institute are encouraged to form a team.
- Each team would comprise of 6 members including the team leader.
- As the software edition of the hackathon is digital product development competition, majority of the team members MUST be well versed with programming skills. For the hardware edition, we encourage multi-disciplinary teams – which means your team should have a good mix of Mechanical Engineers, Electronic Engineers, Product Designers and Programmers.
- Colleges MUST issue a letter on their letterhead stating the names of the team and team members.
- The team leader's name should be clearly specified in the letter.
- · Clearly communicate the email-ids and mobile numbers of all team members as well.
- The Team Name should be unique and not contain the name of your institute in any form.
- . The letter should bear the seal of the college/ institute along with signature of the principal/dean/ institute director.
- . A scanned copy of this letter in PDF form is to be mandatorily uploaded during online application process.
- For <u>Software Edition</u>, after teams are shortlisted, each team will either be allotted 2 mentors or they will have the option of selecting them from the industry or academia. For <u>Hardware</u> <u>Edition</u>, only Industry mentors are encouraged – specifically those with over 5 years of hands on experience in hardware industry.

How do we submit our idea?

Please note: Idea submission must be made by the Team Leader only.

- Submission dates should be strictly followed. No exceptions will be made.
- Submission is required to be done on sih.gov.in in the prescribed format. The format is available on the website.
- . After login, fill in all the required details for submission of the idea.
- . Entries to be sent only in the prescribed format; otherwise they are bound to get rejected.

• Upload the PPT in the prescribed format, stating the idea and letter from the college (as stated above) to complete the application process.

What is a selection criteria?

- Evaluation criteria will include novelty of the idea, complexity, clarity and details in the prescribed format, feasibility, practicability, sustainability, scale of impact, user experience and potential for future work progression.
- Preferences will be given to entries from North east while selecting between two similar ideas.

When/where will the shortlisted ideas be announced?

- Notification about selected teams will be sent to their respective nodal center and will also be announced on the portal.
 - You may keep a track of all the latest notifications and updates about the event through **Smart India Hackathon App** on Google Playstore.

Be available for meetings and training during the preparation phase; will be notified in advance

General information regarding the Grand Finale

- If a team is selected for the final Hackathon, members will need to travel to the assigned center which can be anywhere in India.
- For <u>Software Edition</u>, selected teams will be allowed to have 2 seniors as mentors. Mentors can be professors/teachers/ experienced professionals from industry. On selection, total team size will be (6+2). For <u>Hardware Edition</u>, we may allocate 2 – 3 industry professionals as mentors who will be sponsored by the organizing team for travelling to nodal centers for Grand Finale.
- Each college/institute will be responsible for the travel and accommodation of their teams for the finale.
- Each college/institute will issue a stamped photo ID to each member of the teams selected
- College photo ID is mandatory for participating in the finale.

What are the prizes to be won?

- Prizes for the top winners under different categories are
 - o 1st prize Rs.1,00,000/-
 - o 1st runner up Rs.75,000/-
 - o 2nd runner up Rs.50,000/-

Miscellaneous Information

- Intellectual property (IP) of the idea would belong to the college/institute and the team members jointly. However, team members will make their product available for free for the government institution for which they are working.
- Selected ideas need to be further developed so that they can be productized before the government institution(s) will be able to utilize it; more efforts beyond the finale are required from the selected teams thereafter.
