

FAQs for Smart India Hackathon 2019 - SPOC

How do I register as a SPOC for Smart India Hackathon 2019?

***We strongly encourage all participating team members to begin their team registration process by downloading **Smart India Hackathon SIH App** from Google Play Store.

Q. Who is a SPOC?

A. A single point of contact who is appointed by the respective institute and will be responsible for all SIH2019 related communication.

Q. Eligibility and Roles & Responsibilities criteria of a SPOC?

- SPOC must be a HOD / Principal / Dean/ an authorized Faculty member of an institute.
- SPOC will be responsible for verifying team registrations from their institute / college / university.

Please note: It is mandatory for each SPOC to upload an authority letter on the institute letter head, signed by the head of the institute with the institute stamp at the time of registration. The template of this is available on <http://www.sih.gov.in/collegeRegistration>.

Q. How many SPOC can be appointed per institute / college / university?

A. Minimum 1 and Maximum 2 SPOC(s) per institute / college / university are allowed.

Q. How can one register to be a SPOC?

* Registration for SPOC(s) has to be done by SPOC himself/herself.

** Fake SPOC registrations or registrations made by students on behalf of SPOCs are strictly prohibited!

Download the letter and have it duly filled on institute letter head with signature and seal of the institute.
